Vincent Chiao is Professor and Associate Dean for Graduate Programs at the University of Toronto Faculty of Law. A leading scholar of criminal law and procedure, his research examines the intersection of criminal justice, political morality, and legal philosophy. Professor Chiao is widely regarded for his work on the normative foundations of criminal law, advancing a distinctive approach that situates criminal justice within the broader framework of political theory and democratic governance. His influential book, *Criminal Law in the Age of the Administrative State* (Oxford University Press, 2019), challenges orthodox accounts of criminal law by highlighting its deep connections to public law values and questions of institutional design.
