### **Friends or Foes: Courts and experimentalist market regulation**

The seminar is based on an upcoming book manuscript on the role of experimentalist competition law in EU market regulation. It will present the reasons for which the use of experimentalist governance mechanisms may be appropriate in the implementation of competition law as well as in market regulation more broadly. The particular focus of the presentation will be on the role of courts - either through judicial review or through private litigation - in supporting or even supplementing experimentalist implementation mechanisms. The judicial role will be contrasted to that of other oversight mechanisms employed in experimentalist governance, such as peer review, to explore the extent to which they are mutually compatible.
