- A letter from the partner institution confirming that credits earned at UA School of Law will be applied toward a degree from that university
- A proof of English proficiency by the nominating institution or by TOEFL or IELTS test
- A personal statement describing your background, academic or professional interests and goals, and your motivation to study at The University of Alabama.
- A photocopy of the first page of the passport
- A current photo (jpg format) to be used for the student record card

 A proof of Health Insurance valid in the United States (to be sent after student has been approved for admission)
