Application Procedure	Students are sent the application instructions after the nomination is received. Students are asked to include a copy of their transcripts as well as a photocopy of their passport.
Application Deadline for both Fall and Winter terms	April 2022
Academic Requirements for Admission to the Exchange	Students applying to Osgoode should have at least 3 years of university, including at least one of law school.

Semester Dates	<p>Fall Term 2022 - August 29, 2022 – December 2, 2022 Exam Session dates: December 5, 2022 – Dec. 16, 2022</p> <p>Winter term 2023 – Jan. 3, 2023 – April 6, 2023 Examination dates – April 10, 2023 – April 21, 2023</p>
Orientation Information	Orientation events take place during the first week of Fall term.
Course Enrollment / Registration	<p>Students ballot for courses in early June. Information is emailed to students after their application is processed. All course selections are done online and students are notified of their enrolments in July.</p>
Credit System	Students take between 13 & 17 credits per term (usually 4 courses per term). Classes typically run 2, 3 or 4 hours per week.
Mandatory Course Load for Exchange Students	Osgoode students take between 13 & 17 credits per term (4 courses) but some exchange students prefer to take less. If students wish to complete fewer courses, Osgoode requests confirmation from the home school that permission is given.
On-campus Housing	<p>On campus housing may be available to students who apply by the deadlines. Please note that demand is very high and there is no guarantee of obtaining on campus housing. Exchange students studying at Osgoode typically apply for the Graduate residences (Assiniboine or Passy Crescent).</p> <p>Further information is found at: https://www.yorku.ca/housing/graduate-housing-york-apartments/</p>
